



CURRENT BEST PRACTICES FOR VEHICLE CLASSIFICATION AND RACING

(All vehicles are limited to 1/10 scale running on 2s batteries)

CLASSIFICATION OF VEHICLES

MUD BOSS

- May be built on any 2-wheel drive chassis
- Must be fitted with a Mud Boss-style body

BUGGIES

- 2-wheel drive only
- Chassis must be fitted with an open-wheel style body
- Chassis must be smaller than a Slash (weight, length and width)
- Examples: (Traxxas Bandit, Team Associated RC10B*, Arrma Typhon)

OPEN CLASS (formerly known as "4X4's")

- May be any 2 or 4 wheel drive vehicle
- All body styles are allowed, either open or closed-wheel

LOSI SPRINT CAR CLASS

- Limited to Losi brand Sprint cars in original stock configuration.
- Must be operated with the stock transmitter that was supplied with the car.
- No mechanical alterations or upgrades other than setup adjustments. No upgraded parts or modifications allowed.
- Replacement parts, including tires must be OEM parts.

RACING GUIDELINES:

1. Each individual car can only be entered into one class per day of racing.
2. Heat Races- Each driver may only race one time per heat, per class. (Drivers may use a different car for each Heat.)
3. Mains- Drivers will be assigned one starting position in the mains based on their cumulative score for the two Heat races run in each class entered.
